NOTICE OF EMERGENCY RULEMAKING ACTION

Notice is hereby given that the Director of the Department of Managed Health Care (“Department”) proposes to adopt an emergency regulation under the Knox-Keene Health Care Service Plan Act of 1975 (“Knox-Keene Act”), section 1300.67.005 of Title 28 of the California Code of Regulations.

Government Code section 11346.1, subdivision (a)(2), requires that at least five working days prior to submission of the proposed emergency action to the Office of Administrative Law (OAL), the adopting department provide a notice of the proposed emergency action to every person who has filed a request for notice of regulatory action with the department. After submission of the proposed emergency action to the OAL, the OAL shall allow interested persons five calendar days to submit comments on the proposed emergency regulations as set forth in Government Code section 11349.6.

Included in this notice is the specific text of the emergency regulation that the Department proposes to adopt and the Finding of Emergency pursuant to Government Code Section 11346.1, subdivision (a)(2).
